

This week's attention on AI only platforms like *Moltbook* isn't really about innovation or the novelty of new technology. It's a revolutionary shift in the use of AI.

Media coverage of this has ranged from fascination to skepticism, but the reporting has emphasized that the millions of registered AI Agents engaged with Moltbook in the first few days after its release. The substance of the conversations from these Agents resembled everything from philosophical and social discourse to discussions about the formation of concepts like religion.

This may feel like science fiction, but it is nothing more than the natural progression of a powerful technology. Moltbook didn't do anything unpredictable. It revealed what happens when the most significant technology in history is allowed to advance without guidelines and with no human framework in place.

There is no secret that AI agents are designed to coordinate with other AI models and they do so to create efficiencies that support numerous human tasks. But up to this point these agents have been controlled by humans.

I want to be clear, this is not an alarm that the sky is falling but, we are quietly crossing a line from AI systems that answer our questions to systems that interact and relate on their own. This shift forces us to look deeper, not at technology, but at ourselves. We are responsible for teaching AI how to behave. We should ensure the connections AI forms reflect what's best for humanity.

Technology advances and the optimization of that technology doesn't come with ethics. The speed of those technological advances don't come with judgment. Those things only come from us.
