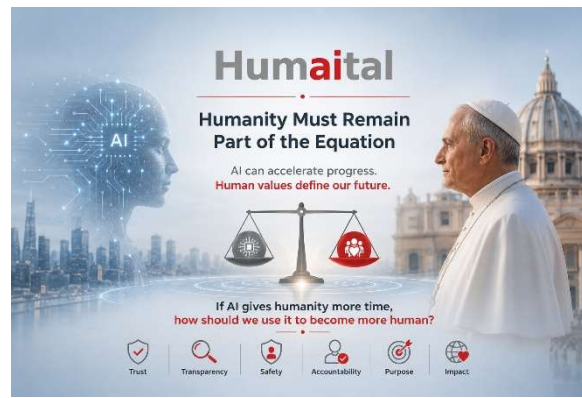


Humanity Must Remain Part of the Equation

Pope Leo XIV may have delivered one of the most important messages about AI of the past week, and it had very little to do with technology itself.

It had to do with humanity.



In *Magnifica Humanitas*, the Pope framed artificial intelligence not simply as an innovation challenge, but as a human dignity challenge. The warning was subtle but profound: if society focuses only on what AI *can* do, while ignoring what humanity *should* become, we risk building a future that is technologically advanced but spiritually and morally disconnected.

That message matters.

Because right now the global conversation around AI is still dominated by creating bigger and faster models, with a focus on measuring productivity, efficiency, capacity gains and operational ROI inside enterprises.

But as leaders we must shift the conversation about AI across business, education, government, to recognize what the deeper questions are:

- What happens to humanity when intelligence is no longer rare?
- What happens to human values, purpose, creativity, and social connection?

These are the conversations Humaital was built around, and the timing of these conversations feels increasingly significant.

That is why we built the Human Alignment Index with the goal to measure whether organizations are deploying AI responsibly and in alignment with human-centered values like Trust, Transparency, Safety, Accountability, Purpose, and Impact.

We know that AI is becoming one of the most defining forces ever to shape society, so how can we ensure that humanity itself will remain part of the equation.

That is also why we launched something intentionally simple, yet deeply thought-provoking, called Humanity Minutes.

It is built around a profound question:

“If AI gives humanity more time, how should we use it to become more human?”

The significance of Pope Leo's message is that it signals this conversation is no longer isolated to technologists and business leaders focused solely on creating organizational value. It is becoming a broader conversation about how we ensure human values, dignity, purpose, and accountability remain embedded within the technology itself.

And that is exactly what needs to happen.
